## ORDER LEVYING PROPERTY TAXES

**WHEREAS**, the Commissioners' Court of Hartley County, Texas convened in regular session on Monday September 13, 2021 at 8:30 a.m. in the Commissioners Courtroom , Hartley County courthouse Channing, Texas. A quorum of the court was present: and

**WHEREAS**, the Court having had one Public hearings on the proposed tax rate, one on September 13, 2021 : and

**WHEREAS**, the Court, having first adopted its budget for fiscal year 2021-2022, now desires to establish a property tax rate to support the 2021-2022 budget;

**NOW THEREFORE**, on motion made, seconded and adopted by the vote indicated below, the Commissioners' Court of Hartley County, Texas, hereby orders that ad valorem taxes on property located in Hartley County for the year 2021 shall be levied and collected from property owners at the following rates, based on each One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) of assessed valuation:

0.3981 Maintenance and Operations  
0.0 Debt Service  
0.3981 Total Tax Rate

**FURTHER**, that the rate as set forth by this Order shall be effective upon the adoption of this Order, and that the Hartley County Appraisal District shall cause tax statements to be prepared and mailed to each of the taxpayers as listed on the Tax Rolls of Hartley County, Texas.


