

## ORDER LEVYING PROPERTY TAXES

**WHEREAS**, the Commissioners' Court of Hartley County, Texas convened in regular session on Monday September 13, 2010 at 8:30 a.m. in the Commissioners Courtroom , Hartley County courthouse Channing, Texas. A quorum of the court was present: and

**WHEREAS**, the Court having had two Public hearings on the proposed tax rate, one on August 20, 2010 and the second on August 27, 2010: and

**WHEREAS**, the Court, having first adopted its budget for fiscal year 2010-2011, now desires to establish a property tax rate to support the 2010-2011 budget;

**NOW THEREFORE**, on motion made, seconded and adopted by the vote indicated below, the Commissioners' Court of Hartley County, Texas, hereby orders that ad valorem taxes on property located in Hartley County for the year 2010 shall be levied and collected from property owners at the following rates, based on each One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) of assessed valuation:

0.305000 Maintenance and Operations  
0.032395 Debt Service  
0.337395 Total Tax Rate


**FURTHER**, that the rate as set forth by this Order shall be effective upon the adoption of this Order, and that the Hartley County Appraisal District shall cause tax statements to be prepared and mailed to each of the taxpayers as listed on the Tax Rolls of Hartley County, Texas.

THERE IS NO INCREASE IN THE TOTAL TAX RATE FROM THE 2010 TO 2011. THIS TAX RATE WILL RAISE MORE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS THAN LAST YEAR'S RATE.
