ORDER PROHIBITING OUTDOOR BURNING

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED by the Commissioners' Court of Hartley County that all outdoor burning is prohibited in the unincorporated areas of Hartley County for 30 days from the date of the Order, unless the restrictions are terminated earlier based on a determination made by the Texas Forest Service or this Court. This Order does not prohibit outdoor burning activities related to public health and safety that are authorized by the Texas Commission on environmental quality for: (1) firefighter training; (2) public utility, natural gas pipeline or mining operations; (3) planting or harvesting of agricultural crops; or, (4) burns that are conducted by a prescribed burn manager certified under Section 153.048, Natural Resources Code, and meets the standards of Section 153.047, Natural Resources Code.

In accordance with Local Government Code 352.081(h), a violation of this Order is a Class C misdemeanor, punishable by a fine not to exceed \$500.00
