ORDER LEVYING PROPERTY TAXES

WHEREAS, the Commissioners' Court of Hartley County, Texas convened in regular session on Monday September 9, 2024 at 9:00 a.m. in the Commissioners Courtroom , Hartley County courthouse Channing, Texas. A quorum of the court was present: and

WHEREAS, the Court having had one Public hearings on the proposed tax rate, one on September 9, 2024 : and

WHEREAS, the Court, having first adopted its budget for fiscal year 2024-2025, now desires to establish a property tax rate to support the 2024-2025 budget;

NOW THEREFORE, on motion made, seconded and adopted by the vote indicated below, the Commissioners' Court of Hartley County, Texas, hereby orders that ad valorem taxes on property located in Hartley County for the year 2021 shall be levied and collected from property owners at the following rates, based on each One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) of assessed valuation:

0.384495 Maintenance and Operations
0.0 Debt Service
0.384495 Total Tax Rate



Language Required in the Motion Setting This Year's Tax Rate:

This year's proposed tax rate exceeds the no-new-revenue tax rate. The vote on the ordinance, resolution, or order setting the tax rate must be a record vote and 60% of the governing body must vote in favor of the adoption of the tax rate. A motion to adopt the ordinance, resolution, or order must be made in the following form:

I move that the property tax rate be increased by the adoption of a tax rate of 0.384495, which is effectively a 3.54 percent increase in the tax rate.

Statement Required in the Ordinance, Resolution, or Order Setting:

This year's levy to fund maintenance and operations expenditures exceeds last year's maintenance and operations tax levy. The following statements must be included in the ordinance, resolution, or order setting this year's tax rate. The statements must be in larger type than the type used in any other portion of the document.
